JOURNALISM & MASS COMMUNICATION ADMINISTRATOR & TEACHER OF THE YEAR

Charles E. Scripps Awards

The Administrator of the Year and Teacher of the Year awards are given in collaboration with the Association for Education in Journalism and Mass Communication (AEJMC). Each winner will receive a \$10,000 cash prize and distinctive trophy at the keynote session during the AEJMC convention Aug. 4, 2010 in Denver. The winners agree to attend. The winners will be recognized at the Scripps Howard Foundation's National Journalism Awards dinner April 23, 2010 in Tampa.

ADMINISTRATOR OF THE YEAR

ELIGIBILITY: This award honors a past or present administrator of a school or department of journalism or mass communication who has provided vision and leadership for the field through creativity and excellence in administration. Award is given for a distinguished career or exceptional leadership in a specific assignment with far-reaching impact. Open to any past or present administrator of a school, department of journalism or mass communication at accredited or non-accredited schools.

Nomination letter should cover information regarding the nominee's accomplishments and examples of outstanding administrative leadership advancing journalism and/or mass communication. Up to four additional letters in support may be included. A recent copy of the nominee's vita is required. No posthumous awards will be given.

TEACHER OF THE YEAR

ELIGIBILITY: Full-time faculty member teaching in a journalism and/or mass communication program who, over a period of years, has consistently demonstrated an environment of excellence by on-going contributions to the improvement of student learning. Nominees may teach in any of the disciplines of journalism and mass communication. Open to accredited and non-accredited schools. Nomination letter by unit head should provide specific examples of the nominee's merit. A recent copy of the nominee's vita is required.
